

Huron Valley Trail Map

Welcome to the Huron Valley Trail. This trail map and guide will help you locate necessities while enjoying your adventure in the splendid Michigan outdoors of southwest Oakland County. The HVT traverses some of the most beautiful, diverse and untouched landscape in southeast Michigan.

It begins at the newly developed Lyon Oaks County Park, accessible from Pontiac Trail, and follows the former "Airline Railroad" corridor westward through Milford Township. The trailway turns southwest into Lyon Township and continues on the former railway corridor to the City of South Lyon.

At I-96 a connector trail heads west toward Kensington Metropark and Island Lake State Recreation Area. The trail to South Lyon is relatively flat with only very gentle grades, while the trail to Kensington/Island Lake offers some challenging hills. A unique boardwalk under I-96 & Grand River Ave. provides access from Island Lake Recreation Area to Kensington Metropark.

The Huron Valley Trail (HVT) is a network of paved trails utilizing the former railroad corridor, connecting the cities of Wixom and South Lyon. The HVT provides direct access to numerous area parks including City of South Lyon McHattie & Volunteer Parks, Lyon Township Community Park, Lyon Oaks County Park, Kensington Metropark and Island Lake State Recreation Area. Vehicle parking and access to the HVT is available at all of these parks. The HVT provides connections to over 25 miles of paved trail. Major road crossing at Pontiac Trail, Grand River Ave., Milford Rd., Ten Mile Rd., and Kent Lake Road also provide access.

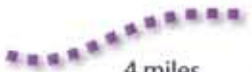
